

Use the grade information below to calculate your GPA after the completion of courses in which you are currently enrolled, using the grades you expect to earn: multiply the point value of the grade by the semester hours of the course for the total quality points, now add the semester hours you are currently enrolled to the number of completed hours you have earned, add the quality points you calculated earlier to the total quality points on your transcript, and divide the total quality points by the total hours for your projected cumulative GPA.

Other grades used:

W (Withdraw): Do not count hours or points

I (Incomplete): Must be replaced by a grade; converts to an F if not completed

NC (No Credit): Count hours and points = 0.00

S (Satisfactory): Do not count hours or points

R (Repeated): Do not count hours or points

Step 1:	
GPA credit hours (from transcript):	76.00
Semester hours enrolled in this term/semester:	15.00
Total hours:	91.00
Step 2:	
Transcript Quality Points:	155.00
Add Quality Points for all C's:	30.00
Total Quality Points:	185.00
Step 3:	
Divide Quality Points by Hours: 185/91	2.03
