What Items will you need to gather to prepare to complete your 2022-23 FAFSA Application?

- Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) for you the student and parent (if a dependent student) is required to complete the FAFSA application. You and your parent will need to access the FAFSA with their FSA ID. Find out how to get an FSA ID and what to do if you forget your FSAID.
- Your Social Security Number (it's important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form
- Your parents' Social Security number if you are a dependent student
- Your driver's license number if you have one
- Your Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- 2020 Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W2 information, for you (and your spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are a dependent student. The easiest way to have your financial information added to your FAFSA application is to utilize the IRS Data Retrieval Tool option in the FAFSA application.
- Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans non-education benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
- Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate (but not including the home in which you live); and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
