Summer 2019 Financial Aid Application – Deadline: April 3, 2019

Eligibility Information

To be considered for summer financial aid

- *Have a 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file at Coker.
- *Be a Coker student enrolled in an approved degree program.
- *Meet the Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress Guidelines at the end of the spring 2019 term.
- *Continuing students must have completed at least 24 hours during the 2018/FA and 2019/SP terms.

Federal Pell Grant (undergraduate students)

- *Students who have received their entire Pell Grant allotment for 2018-2019, who will be attending summer at least half-time (6 credit hours), may be eligible for additional Pell Grant funds. **Please note that this amount will not be enough to cover the cost of summer tuition.**
- *Students who have not received their entire Pell Grant allotment for 2018-2019, may be eligible to receive remaining Pell Grant eligibility in the summer.

Federal Direct Student and/or PLUS Loans

- *To receive loans, you must enroll at least half-time (6 credit hours) during the summer term.
- *You will qualify for Federal Direct Student Loans if you have not used your yearly maximum.
- *Your parent may apply for the PLUS Loan. The deadline to apply for the 2018-2019 year is **April 18, 2019.** <https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/launchPLUS.action?plusType=parentPlus>

Alternative Loans

- *Students may apply for an alternative loan at <https://choice.fastproducts.org/FastChoice/home/342700>

Disbursement of Funds

- *Financial aid disbursement in the summer begins after rosters have been finalized by the Office of Academic Records for each summer session.
- *Student loan funds will not be disbursed to your account until the beginning of the session in which you become enrolled at least half-time. For example, if you enroll in 3.0 credit hours for the 2019/IN May term and 3.0 credit hours for the 2019/E5 term, your aid will disburse after rosters have been finalized by the Office of Academic Records for the 2019/E5 term.

Books

- *If your summer financial aid disbursement exceeds your summer costs, you may purchase books through the Bookstore.

Payment

- *You are responsible for paying the tuition, fees, room, board, etc. charges for the summer term(s) even if you do not receive financial aid.
- *You are responsible for paying any charges on your student account that result as a change of enrollment status.

Withdrawing

- *Financial aid recipients are expected to complete each summer session in which they are receiving financial aid. If you withdraw from classes, or fail to earn a passing grade, you may have an adjustment to your financial aid award. - *You are responsible for paying any charges on your student account or repaying financial aid that may result due to your withdrawal.
