

COKER COLLEGE ENGAGEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The annual Coker College Engagement Scholarships will be awarded to five (5) high school seniors who best meet the requirements set forth by the Selection Committee. Scholarship awards will be applied to tuition and fees. Scholarship amounts will be \$3,500 for four (4) years.

All Coker scholarships and grants will be applied according to the college's financial aid packaging policy. Some institutional awards may be added on top of other awards, but must fall in line with Coker's financial aid packaging parameters.

The Selection Committee will review and score all submitted applications. The committee will select qualified candidates to bring to campus on **Friday and Saturday, February 22nd – 23rd** for an on-campus interview. ***Selected candidates will be required to attend this interview weekend*** in order to be considered for this scholarship.

Guidelines for the Coker College Engagement Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors who have applied and have been accepted to Coker College for the fall 2019 semester. Transfer students are not eligible.

Student applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Have applied and been admitted to Coker College.
2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.25 on the South Carolina scale
OR 2.70 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Students must demonstrate active leadership roles, service, civic engagement, and diverse experience throughout their high school careers.

A complete application consists of:

1. A complete application form (attached).
2. A 500 word essay (described in the application form).
3. A resume of accomplishments, achievements and activities.

All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than February 1st, 2019.
